

Truckee Area Weather Reporting data comes from the Truckee Tahoe Airport District's Automated Weather Observation System (AWOS). That data is confirmed and reported hourly by trained District staff. The information is then distributed and used by both the National Weather Service (NWS) and the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) as the basis for your local weather reports. **LIVE WEBCAM:** truckeetahoeairport.com
