

Aircraft was climbing through 10,800'msl at time of Prosser comment (depicted) and on the Truck Four SID. Aircraft was climbing through 7,200'msl at PCA for Martis Valley Estates residents. Emailed/called commenters and spoke to aircraft owner who said they tried to get out before 10 PM but missed the mark. Aircraft is not a regular visitor and will not likely become one. 

I just heard it.", "Way too low and early, well below 500", "warbird buzzing houses, 3 times", "Extremely loud airplane, absolutely ridiculous", "Low over houses", "bombers low over house, is there a fire?", "Old military plane. If the airport is going to allow the American aeronautical foundation to give \$425 B-25 rides on a Sunday afternoon it MUST instruct them to use proper take off and landing routes. This has been happening all day and it is unacceptable.", "B-25s have been blasting us all weekend, making us duck and cover and raising our blood pressure.", "out of pattern", "Plane flew very low, directly over my house. It was EXTREMELY loud, and shook the inside of my house.", "loud and woke up napping child", "loud again and over neighborhood"

- 2. "Loud jet noises directly overhead my house for 30-45 seconds"
- 3. "I live on Glenshire Dr, close to the Legacy Trail. I hear noise all day long. I just heard LOUD jet sounding aircraft that was super disruptive to my household. Thus happens every day. I've just finally had enough about saying, "well it's high tourism season, it's the air show, it's the holidays...it doesn't matter anymore!" Thus happens daily. I've lived in this house for 6 years and thus year has been the worst! Enough!!"

Staff returned emails to each commenter almost immediately with confirmation and preliminary event info.

Based on speed of aircraft, this is likely a military fighter jet, covering 50 miles in 4:37. Additionally, a Blackhawk helicopter departed at 8:55 PM local with no track. Radio calls suggest it may have also overflown Glenshire. Staff spoke to NAS and confirmed there were multiple exercises last night. Spoke with and sent Ops officer TTAD NAP and curfew info.


