- 3. Establish guidelines for fair and equal treatment of people
- 4. Protect the health and safety of the general public
- 5. Foster quality products, facilities, and services
- 6. Reduce exposure and liability
- 7. Create a platform for conflict prevention and resolution
- 8. Support our Federal Grant Assurances (Promises)

PMCDs and Existing Policy

- 1. PMCDs incorporate guidance from FAA Advisories, handbooks, circulars.
- 2. Existing policy covers topic areas specific to the District. PMCDs cover a wider and more comprehensive range of topics relevant to all airports.
- 3. Existing policies lack guidance on some areas such as:
 - a. Emerging aeronautical use such a skydiving and UAS
 - b. Recent rulemaking related to hangar use
 - c. Renewal and development of leases and agreements
 - d. Use and development of land and facilities
 - e. Rate setting


