

Q1 2019 AGENCY PARTNERSHIP Tahoe Nordic Search & Rescue (TNSAR)

TTAD entered into an Agency Partnership with Placer County supporting the Tahoe Nordic Search & Rescue organization (TNSAR) in November of 2018.

TTAD funded \$395,500 for a new Pisten Bully Snow Cat and International Truck Hauler (to move the cat on surface streets).

TNSAR took possession of the Pisten Bully in February and put it to immediate good use with seven call outs in Q1 2019.

The new truck hauler is due to be delivered late spring early summer. They have been using a borrowed truck to date.
