



North Tahoe Public Utility District

Sewer collection, water and parks service provider serving approximately 5500 sewer/parks customers and 3800 water customers along 8.3 miles of shoreline from the California state line in Crystal Bay to Dollar Hill



Regional Trail System


Placer County has started environmental studies and permitting for the North Tahoe Shared Use Trail now that the 2.2 mile Dollar Creek Shared Use Trail is nearly completed.

Multi-Use Trailhead Improvements Current Project Costs

Construction Contract: \$440,000 Construction Contingency (10%): \$44,000 Executed Change Orders To Date: \$17,000

NTPUD Installed Site Amenities: \$22,000 Bike Racks: \$10,000 Bike Wash and Repair Station: \$9,000 Signage: \$3,000

Engineering/Design: \$15,000

Current Project Total (estimated): \$521,000


