# **July 2019 Operations & Comments Report**



## Operations (Exhibit 1)

- 7,124 operations, an 11% increase from 2018 and 12% increase from 2017
- Busiest day was Friday, July 19 with 362 operations (Tower Count)
- Helicopters down 32%, Turboprops down 10%, Jets up 14%, Pistons up 17%, Gliders up 18%
- TFR's restricted operations during airshow July 12-13


#### Comments (Exhibits 2 & 3)

- 55 households made 201 comments
- The number of households is relatively unchanged compared to the past two years (58 in 2018, 53 in 2017) however we have seen an increase in comments
- 14 new households
- 42 comments were due to aircraft using the 'Truck Four' IFR departure procedure
- 17 comments due to glider tow planes

### Voluntary Curfew Operations 10 pm—7 am (Exhibit 4)

- 62 Non EMS operations, mostly during the 6am hour but also 3 times as many operations in 10pm hour from 2018. This is a 48% increase from 2018 and 38% increase from 2017
- 10 EMS operations including 4 by twin turboprop aircraft




Exhibit 4: Night Ops by Hour
