- Stay focused on our Mission: The Truckee Tahoe Airport is a community airport that provides high-quality aviation facilities and services to meet local needs. We strive for low impact on our neighbors while enhancing the benefit to the community—at-large.
- Reduce annoyance by enhancing air traffic control services, conduct extensive pilot outreach, and promote community friendly flight procedures.
- Enhance safety using all available tools for pilot education, outreach, surveillance, and airfield control, while advancing a safety mindset.
- Bring resolution to the Automatic Dependent Surveillance-Broadcast (ADS-B) question regarding its utility as a tool to reduce annoyance and enhance safety. Inform public, study and understand costs, benefits, and potential community impacts of such a system;
- Complete Hangar 1 project within Budget. Complete Schematic Design (Phase 1) for the Hangar 2 project and bring to Board for and public for discussion and resolution;
- Begin implementation of Greenhouse Gas Emissions Reduction Plan including solar power, transit, and other green initiatives;
- Maintain existing and seek new community partnerships with local agencies and non-profits that benefit the District at large;
- Be a leader and partner in facilitating the construction of additional workforce housing units in an effort to solve the local workforce housing crisis.
- Recognize, celebrate and support an engaged, happy, and productive District workforce using communication as a foundational core principal.
- Complete update of guiding documents including Land Management Plan, Facilities Maintenance Plan, Water System Plan, Wildlife Hazard Assessment, Communications, and Vehicle Parking Plan;
- Develop public transit strategies and programs with other agencies in our region. Support transit connectivity between the District and Reno and Reno Tahoe International Airport.
