After leaving that operation, Bill learned of the need for a controller at the new KTRK tower facility, and was assigned to take the job. "Enjoy camping, fishing and the many outdoor activities in the Truckee Tahoe Area," he says and shares those passions with his family. Being a controller with pilot and instructor experience, along with aviation knowledge, has been extremely useful in his career. Bill has talked several pilots through potentially serious situations, very possibly saving a few lives. One of the most memorable was a pilot flying a Cherokee who announced she had full power but couldn't open the engine, and that her throttle cable had likely broken. Bill confirmed that her engine was running.

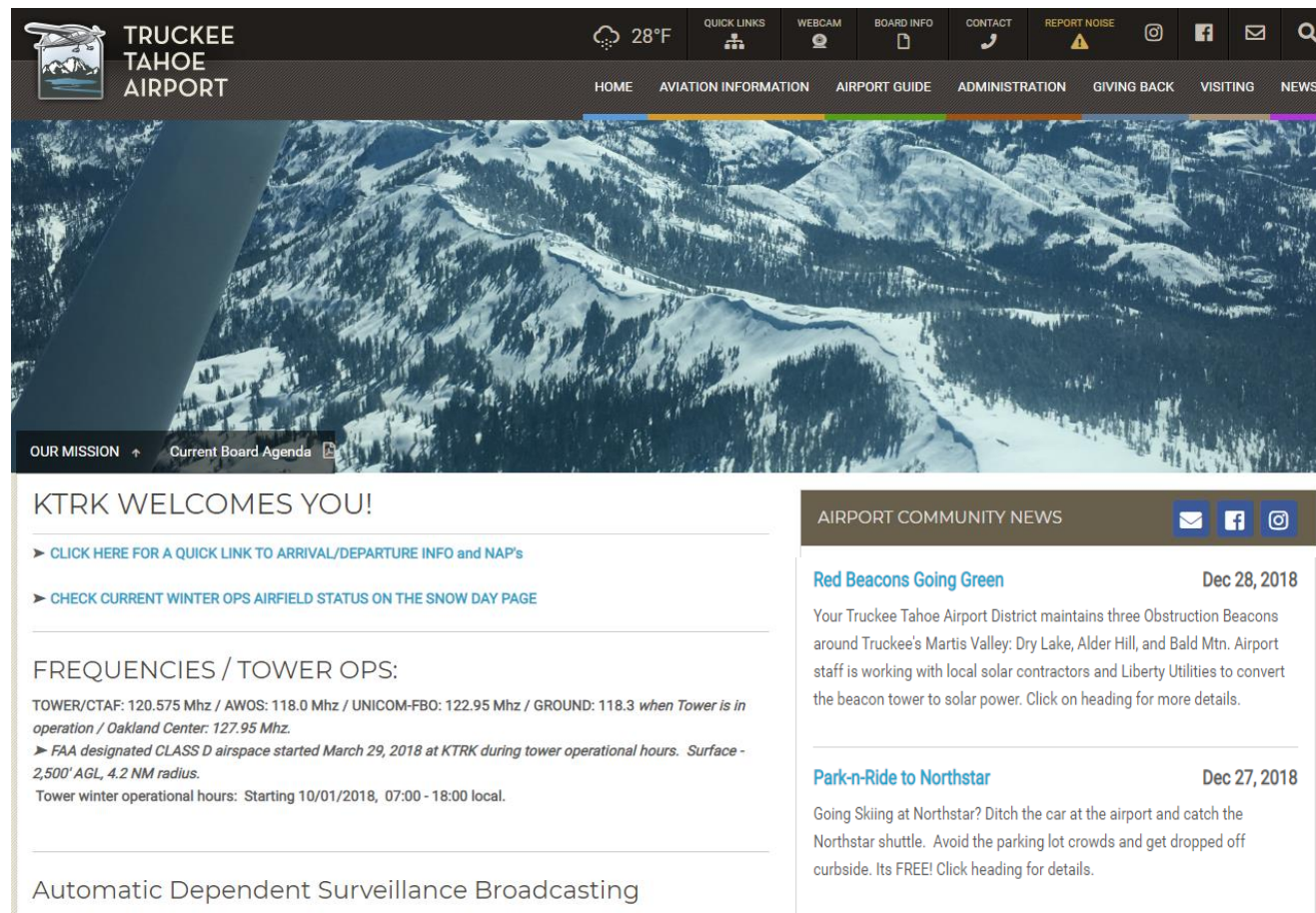

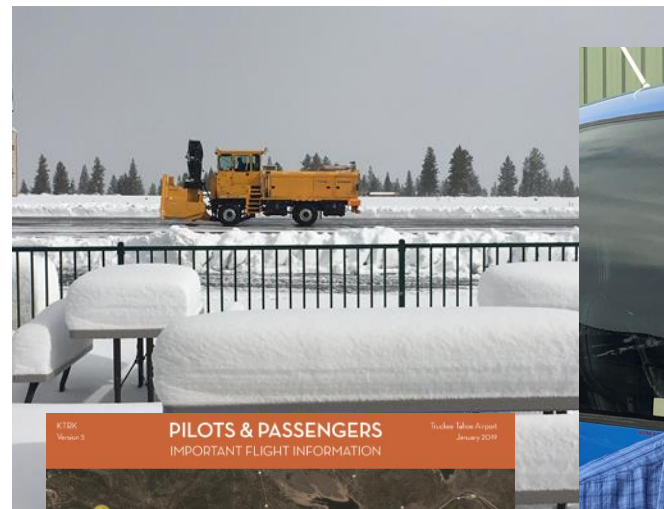
