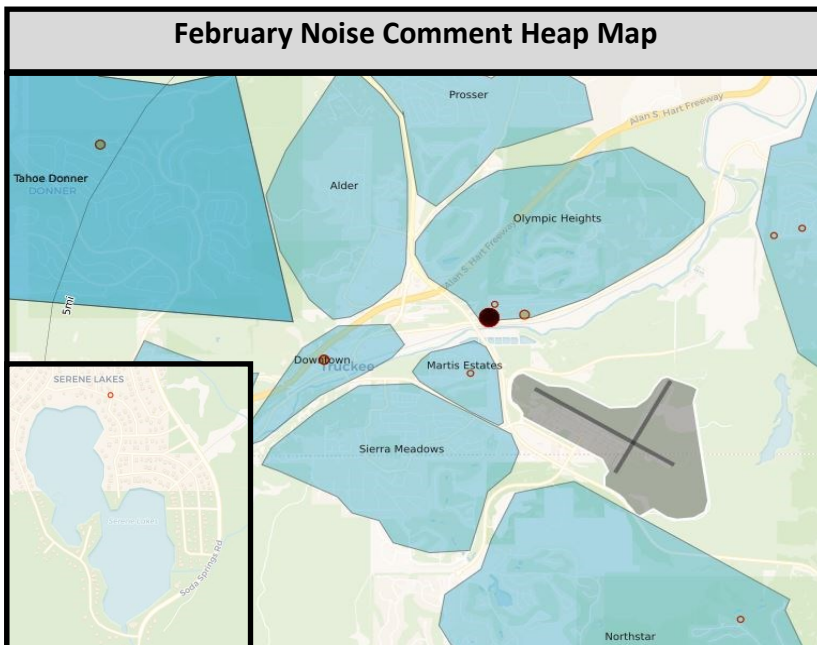


February 2020 Operations & Comments Report

Operations

- 2,350 operations, a 234% increase from 2019 and 16% increase from 2018. Ideal flying conditions compared to record snowfall and runway closures February 2019
- Friday, February 14 was the busiest day of the month with 175 operations (tower count)
- Emergency landing on Runway 29 of a Lancair that lost its power Sunday, February 23. Aircraft landed without incident
