## Operations & Maintenance

- Columbia cart door damaged
- Golf cart damaged

## Aviation

- 2 Incursions:
  - o Airport vehicle crossed Runway 11/29 without clearance from Tower
  - A vehicle entered Taxiway Alpha to get to his hangar during construction of the Care Flight helicopter pad.

## Ramp & Services

- Airport vehicle driving in the hangar rows did not notice an aircraft taxiing
- Airport vehicle damaged in garage while hooking up the water cart

#### Hangars

- 5 Hangar door momentary safety switches bypassed
  - o 3 First offense
  - 1 Second offense
  - o 1 Multiple offender
- 1 Success of the momentary safety switch. Demonstrated the significant reduction in the potential risk of hurting or killing a person, damaging assets, and reducing maintenance costs.

## **OSHA Training:**

- Walking & Working Surfaces

## **Airport Specific Training:**

- Veeder Root System Reports fuel quantity and emergency situations (i.e. overfill, leak)
- Fire Extinguisher/Live Fire Training

# **Construction:** Weekly safety meetings during the construction season

- Consider influence on airport, including aircraft and users
- Review weather and predicted schedules to determine closures
- Evaluate procedures to mitigate FOD and potential aircraft/vehicle conflicts
- Required Runway closures and NOTAMs

**Fire Break:** Mastication of vegetative fuels to improve firefighting capabilities and containment efforts that protect our neighborhoods.

- Located in the northeast quadrant of the airfield
- 340'wide by 2500' long swath running east-west from Runway 02/20 to Martis Dam Rd.
- Ties in with the mastication project on the north side of Runway 11/29 completed in Q1 for wildlife mitigation and fuels reduction efforts

## **COVID-19:** Safety measure compliance efforts

- Written policy and employee reporting responsibilities
- Staff and facility modifications to observe social distance recommendations
- Appropriate COVID signage and safeguards installed
- Personal Protection Equipment for staff and customers
- Building and vehicle sanitization policy and schedule
