Dear Truckee Tahoe Airport Board Directors,

I write this letter to encourage the Airport Board to contribute to the Truckee Springs project. This project is one example of how our airport can enhance our community, spanning from Lake Tahoe to Pyramid Lake, using the tax revenues that come from those communities.
