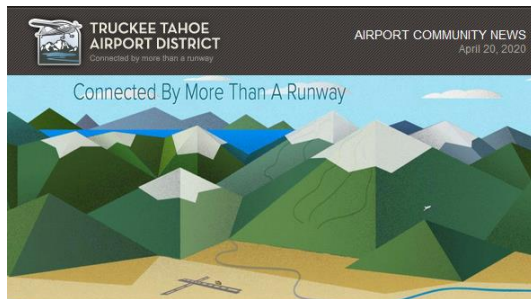

Your Truckee Tahoe Airport District is considered an essential public service element. We will remain operationally ready for any aeronautical demand or community need.

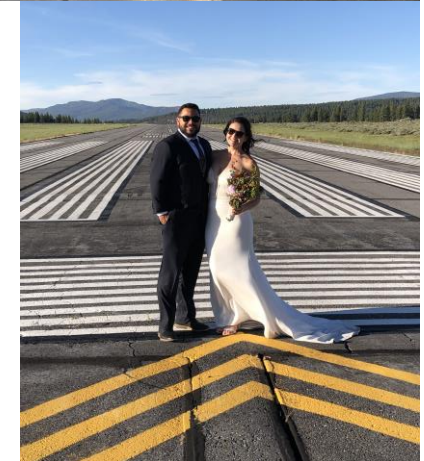
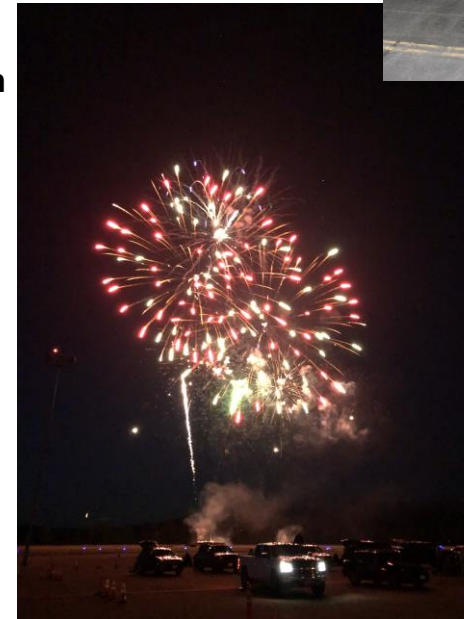
Arrival on Runway 11

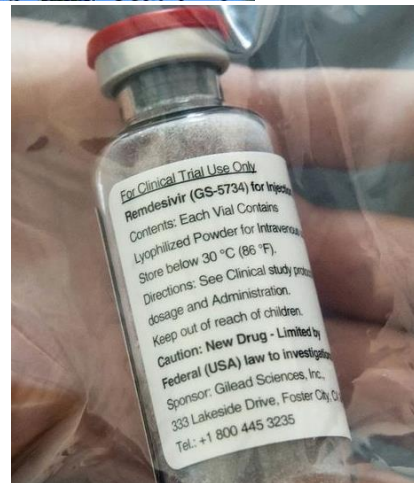

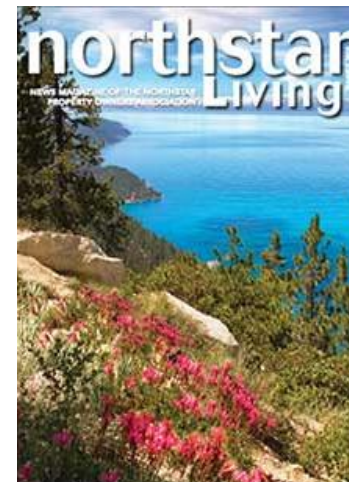
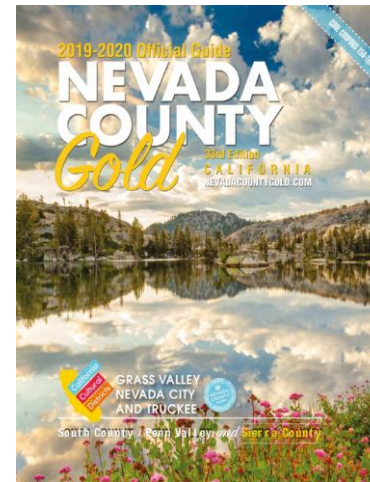
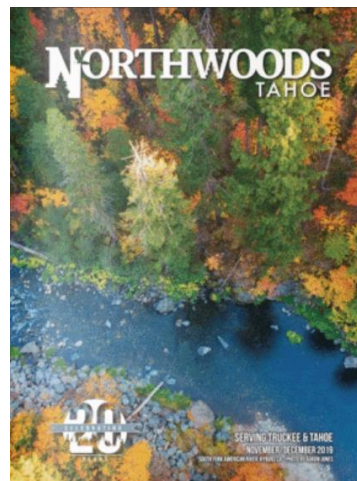
Green Initiatives
