






Control Tower – ADSB Surveillance – Flight Procedures Timeline



Procedure Development Timeline DISCLAIMER

- Estimation based on published FAA and Consultant guidance. This would be a first time accomplished at KTRK, seldom tried and accomplished at regional or general aviation airports.
- Certain airport improvements primarily for new approaches could be required such as Precision Approach Path Indicators, lighting upgrades, signs and markings at District expense.
- Dependent on additional tower surveillance equipment and certification such as certified radar displays and contracts supporting this capacity with Midwest.
- Subject to FAA approval and timelines not within District control.
- Require support and advocacy from elected officials and other Federal employees that manages airspace, facilities, and technology.
- May not reduce annoyance.
- May not be used or adopted by operators in all scenarios.

Departure off Runway 11 Northbound.


Left turn of eastbound runway 11 then northwest.

Other Procedures


Noise procedures, visual procedures, voluntary procedures, arrival procedures.


NOTIONAL (Conceptual) 11-20 North Obstacle Departure Procedure
