**RECOMMENDATION (Approved by Consent):** Accept the staff request to surplus the 1993 Oshkosh Snow Blower and sell at market value or best offer. A picture of the Blower is attached to this staff report.

**DISCUSSION:** The Operations & Maintenance Department has determined that the newly purchased 2020 Larue T85 self-propelled snowblower has met the qualifications of its design and bid specifications this winter. We are now able to ask that the Districts 1993 Oshkosh self-propelled snowblower be designated as surplus property. Once so designated, the District staff will follow the guidelines of PI 319 Disposal of Surplus Property. We are presently in the process of determining the fair market value of the 1993 Oshkosh.

Based on the age of this snowblower, its emissions now exceed what the California Air Resource Board (CARB) will currently allow in California. Therefore, it must be sold outside of the State of California or scrapped since it can no longer be operated in the State. Staff feels there will be multiple parties outside of California that will have interest in purchasing the Blower.

**CONSENT MOTION:** I move to approve the staff request to declare the 1993 Self Propelled Oshkosh Snow Blower as surplus property and to direct staff to dispose of Blower at fair market value or best offer.
