

General Manager's Report

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Item 1 – Upcoming Training/Conference Opportunities

Item 2 – Employee Cost of Living Adjustment

Each June the Board reviews and approves the annual Cost of Living Adjustment (COLA) for District employees. In May of each year Staff provides and estimation of the upcoming COLA planned to come before the Board at the June Board Meeting for approval. Please find the attached *Consumer Price Indexes Pacific and U.S. Cities Average for April 2021*. The current April 2021 index is 3.8%. The May Year End West – Size Class A Index numbers are typically used to set this rate. This is just an informational item for the Board. If the Board or public have any questions on COLA, please let us know. This will be an action item, based on the May 2021 Data at the June 23, 2021 Board Meeting.

NOTE: General Manager is not subject to COLA. GM merit increases and COLA is reviewed together each January.

Item 3 – ACT Update

We are moving along in our launch of the Airport Community Team (ACT). We are planning our first meeting on June 9th at 6:00 PM. The topic will be "Expectations for Summer of 2021." This will include what we expect regarding traffic operations for Summer 2021, when does this traffic come (operational tempo), tools we are using to try and reduce impact, and how community members can keep us informed as to their experience. We have a new ACT link on the website that went live on May 16th. We have a print, radio, and social media campaign going on right now to get word out to the community that there are opportunities to participate on ACT. It is a work in progress, but we hope it will get some momentum and that we can have good participation District wide. We will discuss Board of Director attendance at this meeting on the Board Committee Agenda Item.

Item 4 – EAA Chapter 1073 Building Lease Payment Offset Reconciliation

Per our Agreement with EAA 1073, the District allows rental offsets for community service rendered by EAA volunteer. These are typically associated with Air Show volunteer hours as well as Young Eagle Flights. Most of their rent offsets come from Young Eagle Flights and scholarships each year. As you are aware, due to the pandemic they were not able to conduct Young Eagle flights in 2020 and for the first part of 2021. The Chapter hopes to be able to begin these flights again very soon and will be back on track with their volunteer programs. It should also be noted that due to COVID-19 restrictions, they were also unable to use the EAA building for its intended purpose for the past year. The EAA building has primarily sat vacant for the last 15 months. In 2019 the EAA Chapter was very active with a total Earned Rent Credit of \$38,726.10. Their rent offset obligation was \$14,232. Staff has every expectation that EAA will be able to meet current and future rent offset obligations when they are fully able to leverage their donation, educational, airshow, and Young Eagle programs. Staff would like to defer the EAA Reconciliation for 12 months to allow full recovery of their programs. At that time, we can reconcile 2020 and 2021 rent credits.

Item 5 – Air Show Update.

The Air Show is progressing nicely for our Sept. 11, 2021 Air Show date. We did learn this week that the F-35 Lightning Demo Team from Hill Airforce Base will be coming to our Show. More details will be forthcoming. All other plans and arrangements are on schedule. I will provide a brief update at the meeting.

Item 6 – Budget Timeline for 2022 Budget Process.

We reviewed this item at the April 28, 2021 Board Meeting. Due to scheduling issues, we were not able to reach a definitive date for our 2022 Budget Goal Setting Workshop. Below is our proposed schedule for the 2022 Budget Process.

• Mid-June 2021– Board of Director Budget Kick Off Workshop. This will primarily be a 2022 Goal Setting and Focus Areas exercise to guide budget process.

- June 23rd Send out Budget Worksheets to Board and District Staff
- July 21st Budget Worksheets are due.
- August 25th from 1:30 PM to 4:00 PM Budget Opportunities Workshop
- September 22nd Presentation of 1st Draft of Preliminary Budget
- October 27th Presentation of 2nd Draft of Preliminary Budget
- December 1st Adoption of 2022 Final Budget

Next step in this Budget timeline is to schedule the first Budget Workshop. A new doodle.com scheduling link was sent out on May 20th. We will confirm the meeting time based on results of the poll.
