  - MOTION #1 AUGUST 10, 2021, S: Vice President Diamond motioned to ratify the consensus decision at the July 28, 2021, Board of Directors meeting to cancel the 2021 Truckee Tahoe Air Show and Family Festival based on the following findings:
    - In an abundance of caution as well as respect for those most affected by the accident, the Board and Staff of the District agree cancellation of the 2021 Airshow is in the best interest of the community and District
    - To assist staff to prioritize the District's recovery and mitigation efforts from the July 26<sup>th</sup> aircraft accident.
    - Cancellation is in line with the District's safety expert and staff counsel.

Director Diamond also moved to express the District's appreciation to the Truckee Optimist, EAA 1073 and the Kid Zone for the tremendous effort they put into preparation for the 2021 show. To recognize this effort, Director Diamond moved to approve payment of \$22,000 to each organization per the Air Show Services Agreement. Director Stephens seconded the motion. President O'Dette, yes. Vice President Diamond, yes. Director Stephens, yes. Director Rohlf, yes. Director Hetherington, yes. The motion passed via roll call vote.

# REVIEW AND CONSIDERATION OF LAND LEASE OPTION PROPOSALS FOR TRUCKEE TAHOE AIRPORT DISTRICT SOARING WAY PROPERTIES (TAB 01)

Mr. Smith noted that the District received two proposals from interested parties in leasing land on Soaring way: Tahoe Forest Hospital District and Truckee Rents. Mr. Smith reviewed the non-aeronautical land map of the potential property. Mr. Dylan Crosby, of TFHD, expressed appreciation to the Board for considering the intent to lease the property to TFHD. The board posed various comments and questions to staff. Discussion ensued regarding what is allowed to be built in Zone D of the CLUP, the community's need of industrial land, the need of a strategic plan for the land on soaring way instead of the District being reactive to proposals as they come up, the Hospital District's expansion plans within the Tahoe Basin, and idea of purchasing land in PC-3 (north of the winery) for open space. Ms. Judy Newland, of TFHD provided information regarding the Hospital's master plan and their expansion needs in Truckee and in the Tahoe Basin. They expressed their strong interest in finding a solution or option to lease the proposed property.

- Board discussion ensued regarding the future disposition of this property. General Board consensus was that the District should not lease this property at this time until a more formal land use planning or master
- plan can be completed. There was consensus from the board to not move forward with the land leasing proposal by TFHD, but to include this discussion in the upcoming Master Plan effort planned for 2022.
- DISCUSSION AND DIRECTOR TO STAFF REGARDING THE TRUCKEE TAHOE SANITATION AGENCY (TTS119 A)/TRUCKEE TAHOE AIRPORT DISTRICT (TTAD) REAL PROPERTY EXCHANGE AGREEMENT (TAB 02)

- Mr. Smith noted that the question for the Board to answer today is whether the Board wishes to continue
- with the land exchange agreement with TTS-A currently in place. Tt is staff's recommendation that the
- Board fulfill the contract that was signed in 2019. Mr. Smith reviewed the parcel map. Mr. LaRue Griffen,
- General Manager of TTS-A thanked the Board of Directors and Mr. Smith for their time and reviewed the
- history of the land swap between TTS-A and TTAD. Discussion ensued amongst the Board regarding all the
- agencies in the region coming together to find mutual interest in the land they all have. Various pros and
- cons of the proposal were discussed. There was an idea to possibly have a joint meeting between TTS-A's
- Board and TTAD's Board to find common ground, as well as more public outreach.
