Overview

- In partnership with the Truckee Tahoe Airport District, the committee implemented the provisions of our agreement to design and present the Truckee Tahoe Air Show & Family Festival
 - The Truckee Tahoe Airport District has the opportunity to continue to sponsor the largest family-friendly event in the Truckee and North Tahoe Region
 - By not charging for the AS&FF it allows all families to be able to attend
 - Community response to past shows has been extremely and overwhelmingly positive
 - Over 200 residents volunteer their time to produce this event

Overview-cont:

- 90% of attendees surveyed at the 2014 event indicated the main reason to attend was the airshow portion
 - The 2017 TTAD community survey found that of all the community events sponsored by the district the most important was the Air Show & Family Festival
 - Over 800 individuals have included their names in support of the event as presented in the past years
 - It provides important funding for local non-profit youth serving agencies

Why the Airshow is Safe

- FAA requires an extensive written plan for their approval, and they send at least three flight safety personnel to monitor the show
 - All aerobatic acts must fly in a preapproved “airbox” to guarantee no aerobatic flight over persons on the ground
 - Intensive briefings are held before all rehearsal shows and the full Saturday show with all key airshow personnel, fire, law enforcement, medical staff, volunteers, and the performers
 - The Air Ops Team makes certain that all performers have extensive training in high-density altitude flying

Only Community Allied Agency Coordination Training Opportunity for Key Safety Personnel

- Develop and Train under an FAA approved Emergency Response Plan
 - International Recognition for Safety Plan, International Council of Airshows Pinnacle Award
- Provide an opportunity to gather multiple agencies and run through a plan of action in case of an emergency event
- Integrate an action plan for multiple scenarios to be prepared for any significant injury or event that needs mitigation including MCIs, Weather related, or Natural disaster (Wildfire, earthquake etc.)
- Set up a Multi-Agency Dispatch to coordinate Fire, Law and ERT for responses and identification of medical or law enforcement mitigation during the Airshow.
