**Safety Reports: 10 Total**

### Airfield:

- After clearing Runway 29, an aircraft shutdown both engines and evacuated due to an engine fire warning light (no actual fire). Ryan Widen and Derek Coons responded expeditiously and removed the passengers to a position of safety. Supervisor Mike Ketron escorted Truckee Fire's ARFF truck to the scene and ensured the vehicle was correctly positioned outside the runway safety area. Job well done by our professional staff members!
- 6 Trespassing events.
  - Cross-country skier was observed twice, skating north then south, on the east side of the airport property immediately adjacent to the approach end of Runway 29. Contact was established with a verbal warning.
  - A couple was stopped while walking their dog down taxi lane Romeo. They had no affiliation with aviation or airport business.
  - Two incidents of people being removed from the approach end of Runway 20 while participating in sledding activities.
  - Off-road vehicle tracks bypassing the security gate at lower road near the approach end of Runway 20. The gate, nor the road are property of the airport, but does enable access to airport property.
  - Northstar overflow parking:
    - 5 individuals removed from snowboarding on the airside of the snow berm that separated aircraft and vehicle parking.
    - 2 individuals removed after climbing the snow berm to physically touch and take pictures of an aircraft without the owner present.
    - No Trespassing signs and ropes were installed.

**Aviation:**

- Partial engine failure in flight of N5901G. Instructor took controls, tower cleared the airspace and all runways while the instructor professionally landed safely back at KTRK.
