GIVING BACK

Community Sponsorships: Q1 2022, 10 non-profit and youth education STEM/athletic recipients, totaling \$16,000. The TTAD Board approved raising the annual recipient maximum sponsorship funding level from \$3,000 to \$5,000 when adopting the updated PI 311 at their March 23, 2022, meeting.
