Summary

Mr. Robb Etnyre, General Manager introduced David Love, Airshow Committee Chairperson who reviewed this year's event. Mr. Love thanked all those who supported bringing the Free Truckee Tahoe Airshow & Family Festival back to Truckee this year. The mission of the Airshow is to provide a free interactive, educational, and fun-filled, family-oriented event with all proceeds going to local youth organizations, programs, and scholarships. Our three main non-profit organizations producing the Airshow with over 200 volunteers are Kidzone Museum, Truckee Optimist Club and Experimental Aircraft Association (EAA).

The Airshow Committee has been working closely with Stacey Justesen and the TTAD staff establishing procedures to ensure a safe event. Intensive briefings are underway with airshow personnel, law enforcement, fire, medical staff, volunteers, and performers so ensure safety and emergency preparedness.

The Opening Ceremony will kick off at 10:00am featuring the Mountain Belles signing the National Anthem followed by an introduction of Col. Bud Anderson, last living WWII Tripple Ace Fighter Pilot (100 years young). Performers will take to the sky including Sky Dancer Anna Serbinenko, Vicky Benzing, will fly her vintage 1940 bi-plane; Rich Perkins, will fly a Marchetti SF-260 and Bob Freeman a 30-year air race competitor will fly in a converted Red Bull Racer and a Glider demonstration by Truckee Soaring Association.

Other attractions include Static Aircraft Displays, STEM Expo, Family Festival including bounce house, music, puppet shows, etc., great food and drinks, and a variety of vendor booths. A Speaker Presentation by Col. Bud Anderson in Hangar A10 and EAA will sign up kids aged 8-17 for free flights on Sunday morning.

Mr. Etnyre thanked the Airshow Committee and volunteers for their work putting the Airshow together. He also thanked Stacey Justesen for managing the event for TTAD, working with the Airshow Committee, staff, volunteers, and all agencies involved to make the event a success.
