There are two Board Ad hoc committees (Hangar Use & Master Plan) that I'm recommending be dissolved and the roles and responsibilities of maintaining contract oversight and product development of these areas be turned over to management, with monthly reports to the board of directors. The inherent contract / program management of contractors and TTAD employees would be more appropriately be managed by the general manager. While there is progress on the Master Plan, noted below and on the agenda this month, the Hangar Use and Fly Quiet review is schedule to take place in the coming months as lower priority item due to staff capacity.

# Item 4. Updated Airport Master Plan Schedule, Phase 1

Airport Master Plan: The draft Runway Feasibility Study: Runway Utilization Estimate Paper was distributed to the Board, member of staff and the TTAD Pilots Group for review and comment. The final review of this document is on the agenda for the August 24, 2022, regular board meeting, with Mead & Hunt representative attending the meeting to address questions and take final feedback on the draft. At the completion of Phase 1 scope of work, it is expected the Mead & Hunt and TTAD management will make a recommendation on the five runway alternatives being studied to focus the effort of the Phase 2 Master Plan work.

# Item 5. Landing Fee & Ramp Fee to replace existing Transient Use Fee

Staff report and recommendation for a new landing fee is on this month's agenda.

## Item 6. Flight Procedures

An Instrument Flight Procedure (IFP) Ownership Master Service Agreement has been established with Flight Tech Engineering (5/18/2021), including recent amendments to this agreement in February 2022. Management is working with Flight Tech to move this work forward, while also reviewing the existing plan of action and milestones to update deliverables based on current progress in 2022. Further updates are expected at the September 2022 board meeting after a plan flight validation the next few weeks.
