



 - Public Agencies, Nonprofits, Combination of the two
- Allowable Activities & Proposed Phases
 - Phase 1: Explore, Define, and Initiate
 - Phase 2: Assess Vulnerability
 - Phase 3: Define Adaptation Framework and Strategies
 - Phase 4: Implement, Monitor, Evaluate, and Adjust
- **Timeline**
 - Guidelines (September-October 2022)
 - Solicitation Release (November 2022)
 - Proposals Due (December 2022)
 - Notice of Award (January-February 2023)
- Idea for draft proposal from CTA


