Item 4. Updated Airport Master Plan Schedule, Phase 1 – No Update

Airport Master Plan: At the completion of Phase 1 scope of work, it is expected the Mead & Hunt and TTAD management will make a recommendation on the five runway alternatives being studied to focus the effort of the Phase 2 Master Plan work. Phase 1 is expected to be complete

by the end of 2022. Currently, work on Phase 1 is still focused on noise analysis related to the runway utilization study previously reviewed.

Item 5. Director of Aviation

After a long and thorough due diligence process with our search consultant (ADK), November we completed final interviews from the initial 32 applicants. Thank you to our Board President Kathryn Rohlf, HR - Laruen Tapia, and the ADK Team, along with community leaders (Town of Truckee Manager, and Truckee Donner Public Utility District GM) for their assistance in this process. As a result, I've offered the position of Director of Aviation to Jeff Menasco, and he has accepted. Jeff will start January 30, 2023, after he completes his final retirement processing from the United States Air Force. Jeff will remain on the Nevada County – Department of Defense – Skillbridge program until the end of this calendar year.
