
Heavy winter storms have dominated our activities. We are actively working with GoCivics to aid in our property management and billing processes. Flight Tech Engineering met with us to discuss draft flight procedures and we're working to reschedule flying these for the 4th time due to weather. After this flight we'll proceed with a recommendation.

Operations & Comments

A blizzard in the final week significantly impacted operations of an otherwise mild February with seven days of airfield closures. This month saw seven operations between 10pm—7am, four of which by EMS helicopters based at KTRK. Seven households submitted 46 comments including one household with 30 comments. We heard from one new household this month due to a C-17 Globemaster low-level overflight.
