
#### Director of Aviation

The new pilot micro-site was soft-launched this week, and we also continue to on-board the Bandwango platform to create a more interactive airshow experience and capture demographics of the attendees. Progress is being made with GoCivics and I look forward to leveraging this platform to reinvigorate our hangar policy program. We are postured to be become the first airport in CA to use a new FAA Camera program to provide better weather observation data. Lastly, we flew the proposed flight procedures and gained first hand knowledge; I anticipate providing recommendations along with a safety analysis in May.

## Operations & Comments

Record-breaking snow closed the airport 6.5 days and restricted large aircraft. Two non-EMS operations occurred between 10pm—7am by local aircraft within their Fly Quiet Incentive agreements. Six households contacted us, one resident submitted 32 comments; many about aircraft flying proficient Bypass Departures. No new households reported.
