- 119 District more than it doesn't, and that Parcel B was purchased with public revenue and is not considered
- aeronautical, and would likely remain in that status. Further discussion ensued related to transferring a
- landslide property to airside property could mean any revenue that could be generated on the landside is
- forever transferred to the airside and not available for landslide improvements or community use.
