
Director of Aviation

In early May myself and Director Hetherington attended the UC Davis Aircraft Noise Emissions Sypmosium; a Board Report is attached. The Bandwango Airshow Mobile Pass should have a Test Site stood up May 19 and will be ready to go for the airshow. TTSA signed a Letter of Agreement with TTAD and our Air Traffic Control tower, and we holistically reviewed their Standard Operating Procedures (SOP) for this summer's operations; no issues. We continue to make progress on the pilot micro-site and met with Director Diamond on May 18 for feedback. Progress continues with GoCivics as well as the analysis of the proposed flight procedures.

Operations & Comments

Unusually high number of touch-and-go operations generated 32 comments. Seven non-EMS operations occurred between 10pm—7am; 5 were local pilots within their FQ windows, 1 waiver for a student requiring 'night' flying, and 1 waiver for safety of flight. Ten households contacted us; two were first-time callers after a military jet overflight. KTRK Familiarization Program saw its first flight of the year.
