- SUBJECT: TECHNOLOGY INFRASTRUCTURE
- **PURPOSE:** To establish district policy for the maintenance and replacement of the District's technology infrastructure.
- **DEFINITION:** Technology Infrastructure shall include all District property and services in the following categories: computers, servers, software, networking equipment, data services, printers, copiers, Fax machines, telecommunications equipment, audio and video recorders and projectors, and security devices.

POLICY:

- 1. TTAD technology infrastructure shall support the District mission, not drive the mission.
- 2. The General Manager will periodically review the long term technology infrastructure needs of the District and address these needs during the annual budget review.
- 3. Staff shall take all necessary steps to ensure that business and administrative data is preserved in a safe, secure, and accessible fashion.
- 4. The District will manage it's technology resources in balancing the following goals:
 - a. Maximize staff efficiency;
 - b. Minimize costs;
 - c. Meet District needs.
