





GOALS OF REVIEW COMMITTEE


- Run a fair, equitable process that adheres to criteria in Policy Instruction 311
- Apply a standardized scoring rubric to be as objective as possible on each application
- Ensure aggregated scoring matches committee intent
- Ensure final funding recommendations align with TTAD mission and priorities and comply with Policy Instruction 311
- Capture opportunities for process improvement





HIGH LEVEL APPLICANT DATA

- 17 Applications
 - **13** Prior AP applicants
 - 12 previously funded through AP
 - 1 previously funded through airshow
 - **4** New AP applicants
 - 3 previously funded from other TTAD sources
 - 1 has not received any prior TTAD funding
- \$1,864,553 in total requested
 - Highest **=** \$500,170
 - Lowest = \$10,000
- **\$500,000** in budgeted funding available
- Average operating budget = **\$2,888,462**
 - Highest = \$20,207,867
 - Lowest = \$10,000
- **63%** = Average % of Agency Partner contribution
- **37%** = Average % of TTAD request
- Most prevalent district Public Purpose = STEAM education (11 projects)
- All submitted Formal Resolutions on time 🎉
