RECOMMENDED ACTION: Staff is requesting that the Truckee Tahoe Airport District (TTAD)

Board of Directors review and make final funding determinations on three Community

Sponsorship funding applications received in February 2024.

<u>DISCUSSION</u>: The Community Sponsorship funding applications included in this report meet the definition of serving a *Public Purpose* of TTAD, as defined in Policy Instruction 311. Staff is recommending approval of these three requests.

<u>Headwaters Science Institute</u>, \$5,000 funding request in support of a 6-week after school science program at Truckee Elementary in partnership with the Boys & Girls Club of NLT's after school program. PI 311 Public purpose: Youth STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Art or "Aviation" and Math) and Environmental education.

<u>Tahoe Community Nursery School</u>, \$2,500 funding request to support an environmental education camping trip with students and parents. Topics include forest, riparian and lake environments, native wildlife, night skies and leave-no-trace garbage pickup. PI 311 Public purpose: Youth and adult STEAM and Environmental Education

<u>Pathways To Aviation</u>, \$2,500 funding request in support of youth "Careers in Aviation" education programs. Their next speaker event, "Women In Space" with Eileen Collins, 1st

female commander of a Space Shuttle Mission, will be held at UNR on 3/21. All TTUSD students are invited. A KTRK hosted Pathways to Aviation speaker event will be scheduled later this year, the exact date still to be determined.

<u>WHAT'S NEXT</u>: Notifications of TTAD Board determinations will be emailed to applicants no later than 48 hours after the board meeting. Checks will be generated and mailed to all Board approved Community Sponsorship funding recipients within two weeks.

FISCAL IMPACT: If the Board adopts by consent, the staff recommended funding determinations of the three eligible applicants for the February 2024 Community Sponsorship application cycle, a total of \$10,000 will be awarded.

These three Community Sponsorship funding awards, totaling \$10,000 in February, will bring the year-to-date total of awards to \$20,000, out of an available 2024 \$100,000 budget for <\$5K Community Sponsorships.

PROPOSED MOTION: I move to (approve, continue, deny) the three PI 311 eligible Community Sponsorship applications received by the Truckee Tahoe Airport District in February of 2024, in the amount of \$10,000, as presented in this staff report.
