1. Truckee Tahoe Workforce Housing Joint Powers Authority (TTWHA) Update – Lauren Tapia

The TTWHA Board of Directors met on March 20, 2024, from 8:30 am – 11:00 am. The Board received a presentation by it's Development Consultant, Ms. Shellen Rodriguez, where the top four, member agency owned parcels, identified in the strategic plan for workforce housing development were reviewed. It was recommended to the Board to select the top two potential development sites for Ms. Rodriguez to pursue further analysis and due diligence. The Board selected the 11.2 acre site adjacent to Alder Creek Middle School (owned by TTUSD) which has a potential of being home to 44-66 units, and Hobart Mills site (owned by USFS and potentially leased by Nevada County). The Board also received a presentation from James Marta & Co on the 2022/23 Financial Audit. The Board accepted the 2022/23 Financial Audit as presented. On May 15, 2024, there will be a Board Retreat where the Board will do a Strategic Plan check-in and receive Funding Plan updates. March 20, 2024, Board Packet. Next meeting: May 15, 2024.

2. Town of Truckee River Revitalization Steering Committee – Jeff Menasco



Downtown River Revitalization Strategy

R2SC met on March 5, from 5:00-7:15 pm. Focus of the meeting was to coalesce the themes of the R2SC for community feedback. The themes are Restore, Revive, and Re-imagine. Under each of these are potential goals which the consultant will get feedback on from the community. The

first half of April will have a focused outreach to the East & West River businesses. Staff is also using the Chamber, and Downtown Merchants Association for outreach on these themes. Two river corridor residences will join the R2SC in April, the canvasing of the area resulted in interest from 10 people, Town Council will select the 2 members.
