

Director of Aviation

Hangar Revitalization outreach has continued. We have 10 volunteers for revitalizing their hangars this summer and anticipate being able to do all 10 hangars. We are addressing aircraft that have not flown for an extended period as well as tenants that have not used their hangars for aircraft storage over a long period.

Fly Safe events have been well attended and we will seek feedback from pilots on desired topics. With TTSA operations beginning on May 15, we are working to ensure TTSA and TTAD are synchronized with our Tower Letter of Agreement and will meet with all parties before operations begin.

Operations



March operations were about 10% below average for recent years and Q1 operations are about 15% less than average. The main trainer aircraft that typically flies several hundred operations a month went down for its 100 hour inspection early March and will not be back online until May. Snow events resulted in five days of partial airport closures.

Fly Quiet

Fourteen households reported aircraft annoyance in March with 33 comments; one house with 15 calls. Using standard deviation as a check for outliers, the standard deviation for this data set is 3.34. By limiting this household to one standard deviation, the new comment total is 22 by rounding up. Two Shoulder Hour operations were used successfully without comment and there where no Quiet Hour violations.




