



Item 2. Winter Damage Hangar Repair Status


Contract hangar damage repairs have been completed and we are in the process of closing out the contract terms and final insurance claim. Attached is a diagram of the hangar repair work along with hangar revitalization. The hangar waitlist and prioritizing returning tenants to recently repaired hangars and new tenants into newly vacant hangars has been a priority this past month. See AvCom Report for updated information on hangar waitlist placements.

<u>Item 3. CalFire – Waddle Ranch – Controlled Burn Plan 2024</u>

CalFire conducted a controlled burn in Waddle Ranch. The low intensity broadcast burn covered approximately 40 of the planned 75 acres. Areas 2 and 3 below are being prepared for future fuel reduction projects in 2025.

CalFire has also awarded TTAD a Grant for the following project: This Vegetation Treatment Plan (VTP) project will facilitate continued vegetation management on the Waddle Ranch preservation area owned by the Truckee Tahoe Airport District (TTAD) under a conservation easement with the Truckee Donner Land Trust. The project area is south and east of the Town of Truckee and east of Highway 267. Treatments will include piling/burning and broadcast prescribed fire on 300 acres. The grant is required to be implemented on a reimbursable basis between the years 2025-2028.

Total State Grant not to exceed \$ 1,499,960.00



Item 4. FAA Part 13 Close Out

The FAA's Airport Compliance Safety & Standards Branch has notified TTAD that both the parachute operator and Truckee Tahoe Soaring Association Part 13(s) has been withdrawn and

dismissed. The Truckee Tahoe Soaring Association has signed a new 3-year lease agreement with TTAD to utilize the Northeast Quadrant Glider Port during the summer season.
