


Glenshire To Hirschdale Egress Project

Total Project Cost:	Estimated: \$1,700,000	Funding Source:	Truckee Tahoe Airport District: \$800,000
		Match Source:	Truckee Fire (Measure T): \$900,000+
Project area:	Includes 414 acres of privately owned land east of the Glenshire community. Steep slope with critical evacuation routes including Martis Peak Road, Glenshire Drive, and Hirschdale Road.		
Purpose:	High priority CWPP implementation project - Evacuation route improvement / strategic shaded fuelbreak		
Anticipated Deliverables:	Project will treat approximately 414 acres through mechanical thinning and biomass removal. Prescription includes commercial thinning of trees less than 30” DBH to achieve adequate horizontal tree spacing, and mastication/chipping of brush and residual material to reduce ladder fuels across the project area. Treatments designed to reduce wildfire intensity and severity and improve forest health conditions.		
Permitting Strategy:	THP exemption – Forest Resilience exemption (1038(f)) permitted by CAL FIRE.		
Schedule/Status:	Anticipate exemption to be submitted to the State by June 2025. Project implementation to start in July 2025, and completion by November 2025.
