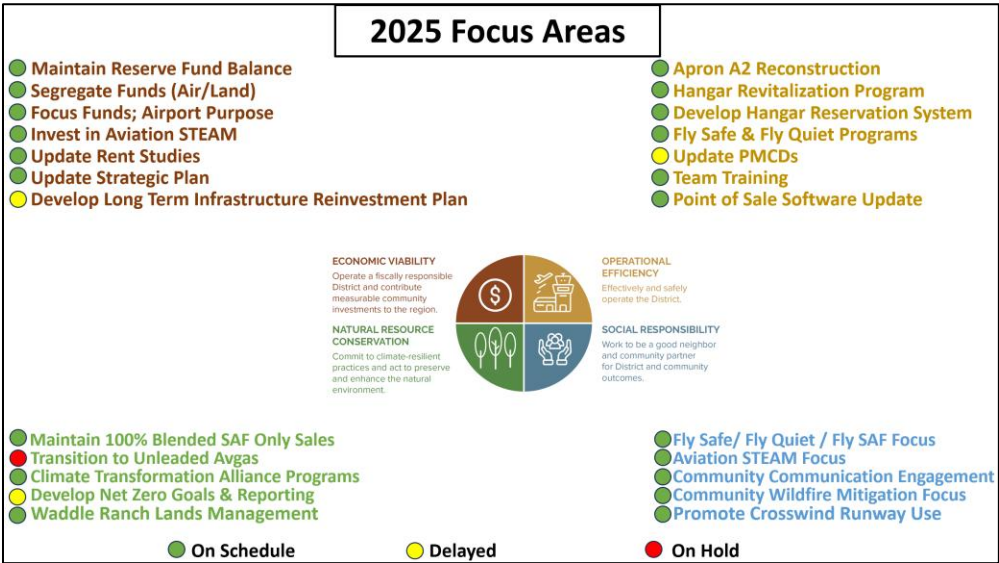

Item 2. Apron A2 Reconstruction

Pavement for Phase II of the Apron A2 Reconstruction is complete, with the final painting of circles and lines expected the week of October 20th. The boiler room construction for hydronics of the concrete pad is being finalized. A project final closeout/summary report is expected for the December 3, 2025, regular board meeting.

Item 3. California Air Resources Board – Aviation Sector

The California Air Resources Board (CARB) hosts monthly evening community meetings to provide updates on Clean Transportation Incentives. During these meetings, CARB staff will discuss updates about incentive project funding and implementation for zero-emission transportation and mobility projects. These projects help improve air quality and reduce the impact of climate change. We encourage community members to ask questions, provide suggestions, and give input on their clean transportation needs.

- (1) California's Strategy to Reduce Emissions from the Aviation Sector, and
- (2) Clean Transportation Incentives.
