**1. Truckee Tahoe Workforce Housing Joint Powers Authority (TTWHA) Update** – Lauren Tapia

I was absent from the March 18, 2026 regular Board meeting. The following update has been provided by the Executive Director, Ms. Heidi Volkhardt Allstead:

*“The Board provided direction to maintain the current JPA structure for one year (status quo) and to engage a consultant to explore the formation and feasibility of a Regional Housing Finance Authority. This approach allows us to continue existing programs while more fully evaluating long-term governance and financing options. Board members also affirmed that the current programs and concierge services provide a unique regional function that their individual agencies do not offer. The Board plans to hold a special meeting in April to finalize this pathway, along with a one-year budget aligned to this direction and an updated strategic plan. Additionally, the Board approved the selection of a web development firm to support the agency’s website redesign, funded through the NTCA grant. While this expense may seem counterintuitive given the one-year horizon, the agency will continue operating programs during this period. The current website is outdated and noncompliant, making it unusable for program delivery and public access.”*

Staff requested that the Board consider authorizing Executive Director Sara Van Siclen to sign an Argument in Favor of Measure K on behalf of TNT/TMA.

The TNT/TMA Board approved this request. Measure K, which will be placed before voters by the Town of Truckee, would renew the existing ½% local roads sales tax. The measure would continue a current funding source used to maintain and repair local roads, bridges, sidewalks, bike lanes, storm drains, and related infrastructure. The tax would be renewed at its current rate and would not result in a tax increase.
