Summary of August 13th Regular Meeting

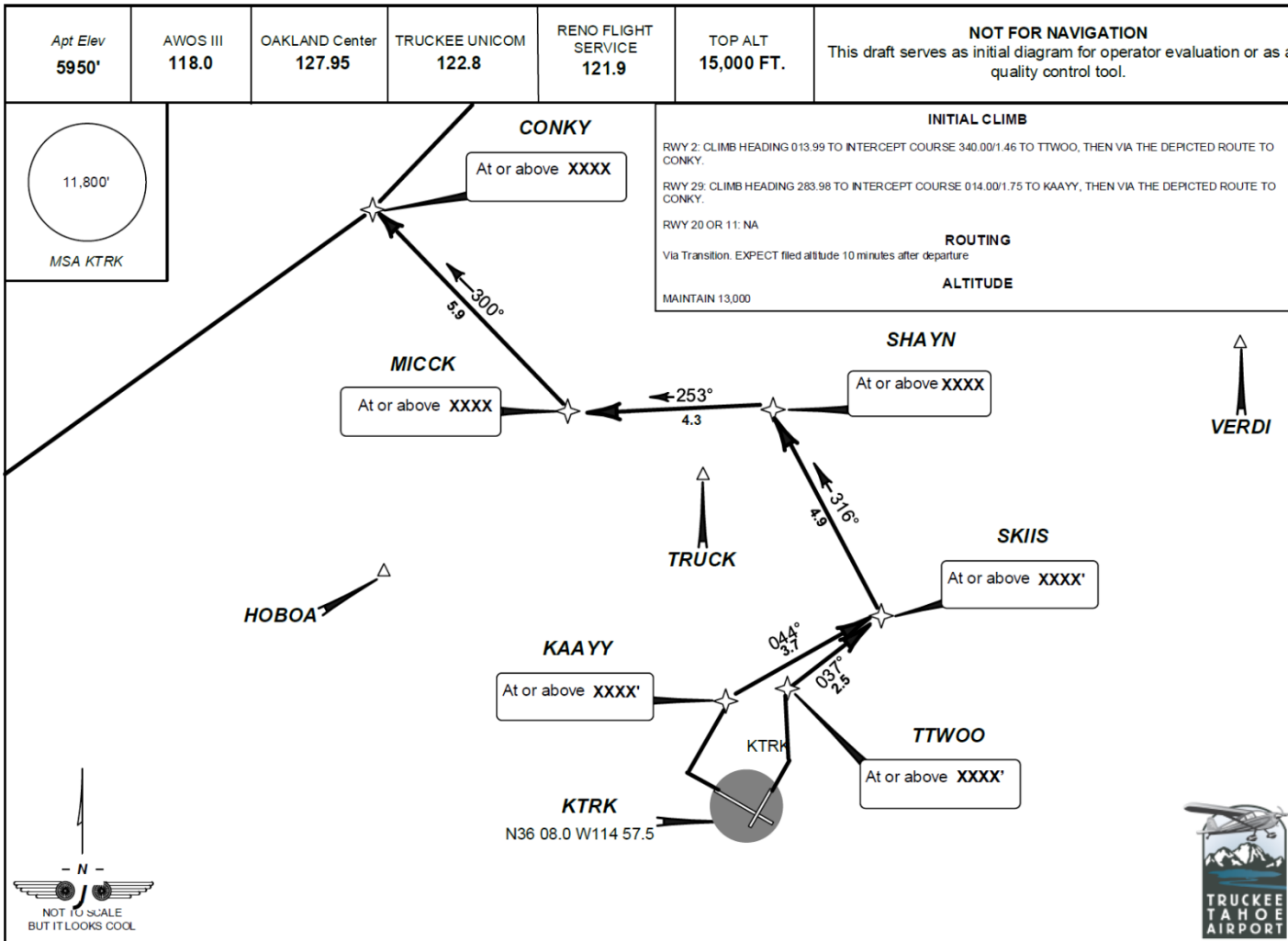
- RNAV Departure Phase 2: Pete Elmore of Next Gen Aviation Consulting Partners
