Topic: Sale of Surplus Snow Blower

Purpose	Information:	Guidance:	Decision: X
Recommendation	Direct staff to enter into a sale agreement with the Placer County Department of Public Works for the transfer of ownership of the 1975 Idaho Norland snowblower for the sum of \$1.00 (one dollar).		
Last Action	The Board of Directors authorized the purchase of a new airport snowblower using FAA AIP grant monies, with 5% matching funds provided by the District. Specifications were written, approved by the FAA, bids solicited and accepted. The Board of Directors and the FAA awarded the purchase contract, and the new machine arrived in January, 2011.		
Discussion	The Idaho Norland was purchased in 1975 with District funds for \$102,396. It currently has a net book value of \$0. In researching new machines, staff visited other agencies and companies that owned and operated large snowblowers. Placer County Department of Public Works operates various makes of blowers, and during the visit and discussion with their maintenance personnel, they expressed interest in the Idaho Norland. In a letter to the District's General Manager the Public Works Manager of the Road Maintenance Division recently verified their interest in having this machine.		
Fiscal Impact	The District will experience a net revenue of \$1.00 (one dollar).		
Communication Strategy	Staff recommends that a press release publicizing the transfer of ownership to another local agency be initiated. TTAD's next newsletter may also feature this event.
