SUBJECT: Financial Report, April 2015

## Revenues:

For the seven months ended April 30, 2015, Airside Operating Revenue was 17%, \$203,000 under budget on a year to date basis as well as slightly under the prior year. The Net Airside Revenue, \$521,000 (after deducting the Cost of Sales) was 2%, 10,000 over budget. Fuel costs are down about 33% from budgeted amounts. Similar to last year, this is a slow time for fuel sales. A robust summer will make a significant difference. Hangar Revenues were 5%, \$37,000 over budget on a year-to-date basis, and Other Business Leasing Revenues were 13%, \$12,000 over budget. Warehouse Revenues are down 7% or (\$12,000) with vacancy in warehouse space.

## Cost of Goods Sold:

Fuel costs are down from budget by 34%, (\$229,000) which corresponds to the decrease in fuel cost per gallon. Gross profit on fuel is 42%.

Payroll and Employee Benefits:

Total Payroll, Benefits and Allocations are \$26,000 4% over budget. The following contributes to this difference:

- Wages, Salaries and Other Compensation of \$36,000, 5% over budget, there was overlap on one full-time position in Operations, instead of having a more usual vacancy and merit raises were awarded; staffing is now 20 full time staff.
- Employee Benefit Insurance, Workers Compensation Insurance and Training and Other are under budget combined by \$11,000 or 3% under budget.

Operating, General and Administrative Expenses are under budget \$323,000, 18% for the six months ended April 30, 2015. Repair & Maintenance expenses were under budget by \$233,000, 61% for the same period.

The hangar waitlist as of 5/18/15 is:

- 9 individuals on the executive hangar waitlist
- 15 current tenants on the transfer list, primarily looking for executive-sized hangars
- 8 individuals looking for vehicular/end pocket units (non-aeronautical)
- 16 vacant hangars; 3 used for storage, 3 need repair, 5 available for rent, 2 used for nightly rental-1 executive, 1 T hangar

We have a temporary waitlist of three T-hangars until the Golf/Hotel row pavement project is completed. We are attempting to relocate as many of Golf tenants as possible until those hangars are back online September 2015.
