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REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS TRUCKEE TAHOE AIRPORT EXTERIOR HANGAR PAINT 2025

DUE DATE: September 25, 2024, 4:30 pm

SCOPE: Hangar C, Hangar D—exterior metal siding (green) and man doors (white). Door identification stickers (to match existing).

TIME: Work shall commence and be completed during the 2025 Truckee painting season. Truckee Airport is open 7 days a week. Work may be performed 7 days. Coordination with airport representatives to be expected as air traffic and hangar tenant requirements change.

PUBLIC WORK, DIR: This is a Prevailing Wage Project, Nevada County CA. Contractors are subject to CA Public Works Contractor Department of Industrial Relations (DIR) registration requirements, Labor Code 1725.5, prior to bidding. Contractor shall be appropriately licensed, bonded, and insured.

MATERIALS & SURFACE PREPARATION: All paint and Prep 88 shall be provided by Warehouse Paints, Auburn, purchased by Truckee Airport. Contact: Randy Albright, Outside Sales Consultant, Warehouse Paint 530-885-7914. Contractor shall place the paint order. Contractor is responsible for following specifications provided by Warehouse Paints and manufacturers recommendations for substrate prep and paint application, including recommended mil thickness.

Surface Preparation: 1st remove all dirt, loose paint and foreign material with mechanical scrub or high-pressure water using a prewash cleaner of PPG Prep 88 Cleaner.

Exterior Metal Green Hangar Repaint: 1st coat: PPG Pitt-tech Plus Satin Industrial Acrylic DTM.
2nd Coat: PPG Pitt-tech Plus Satin Industrial Acrylic DTM.

Black Vinyl Die cut door identification sticker purchase and installation is the responsibility of the contractor.

PROJECT NOTES: Water & Power provided by Truckee Airport. Protection of adjacent exterior surfaces by contractor including, but not limited to, pavement, signage, windows and translucent fiberglass panels, fire alarm, lights, antennas, cables and wire. Painting shall cease if Aircraft and Autos approach the vicinity. Protection of aircraft, autos and miscellaneous stored items inside hangar interiors shall not be the responsibility of the contractor, however, paint shall be applied in such a manner as to avoid spraying hangar interior. Paint shall not be applied during windy or adverse weather conditions. Ladders, Scaffold, High lift equipment, Fall Arrest equipment supplied by contractor. Trash removal, contaminated paint or solvent disposal is the responsibility of contractor.
