PROPOSED HANGAR 3 - Options 1, 2 and 3

The Truckee Tahoe Airport District is considering three options for a new aircraft hangar that could double as a community and event space, and would like community feedback.

From a basic hangar and event space, to a fully accommodating facility to put on a serious soirée with a kitchen, the Airport District wants to know what the community wants and will use. Price tags for these various building options range from roughly \$3 million to \$9 million. The Board of Directors of the Truckee Tahoe Airport District is currently assessing these options to find the best fit for the Airport and the Truckee-Tahoe community.

Working with recently launched FlashVote, an Incline-Village based survey service that has been serving the Incline Village General Improvement District and the North Lake Tahoe Resort Association, the Airport is seeking opinion and input at:

Here are the options the public is being asked to weigh in on:

OPTION 1 - First up is a fairly basic hangar that can house small to large sized aircraft including business jet with warming and de-icing abilities. As an event space, it can host up to 222 people, but would require portable toilets, and doesn't include a kitchen space for event food prep. Estimated Price: \$3M.



OPTION 2 - Next up is a hangar that can still house small to large aircraft and perform warming functions, but also adds a more aesthetically pleasing finish for community events, in-floor heating, its own backup generator and restrooms for 200 people. Still no kitchen facilities. Estimated Price: \$6M



OPTION 3 - And third is a hangar that builds on the above features - space for small to large aircraft with warming and de-icing abilities, in-floor heating and a backup generator - adding restroom facilities for up to 600 people, more community meeting space, a commercial kitchen area and exterior canopies. Estimated Price: \$9M



The District currently has the funds in reserve to construct the options presented. The District Board of Directors is very interested in receiving additional public comment and these options prior to making a decision and committing public funding to this project.
